Patient Education Fact Sheets

American Academy of Sleep Medicine Institutional User Site License Agreement

By submitting payment, the facility or individual identified ("Licensee") agrees to adhere to and abide by all terms and conditions set forth in this license agreement ("Agreement"). In turn, the American Academy of Sleep Medicine ("AASM") agrees to grant the Licensee and Authorized Users at the Authorized Site, as defined in this Agreement, the non-exclusive, nontransferable right to access the AASM's fact sheets. If you do not agree to any of the terms and conditions, you must refrain from using the fact sheets.

Terms and Conditions

1. Definitions.

- 1.1. Authorized Site. An Authorized Site is an organization that is under a single administration and may be academic or nonacademic.
- 1.2. Authorized User. An Authorized User is any individual who is an active employee, faculty, staff, student and/or patient officially affiliated with the Licensee. Authorized Users may be persons remote from the Licensee's physical location whose access is administered from the Licensee's site, but not persons at remote sites with separate administrations. This Agreement extends only to the Licensee and such Authorized Users individually, and may not be transferred to, or extended to, others.

2. Agreement.

- 2.1. Licensee Undertakings. The Licensee is responsible for:
 - 2.1.1. Taking reasonable measures to enforce the terms and conditions of this Agreement and prevent Prohibited Use of the fact sheets, and for notifying the AASM of any infringement of copyright or Prohibited Use of which the Licensee becomes aware.
 - 2.1.2. Cooperating with the AASM in investigating any Prohibited Use and taking reasonable steps to ensure the cessation of such activity and to prevent any reoccurrence.
 - 2.1.3. Undergoing common and reasonable methods to inform Authorized Users of general terms and conditions for the use of the fact sheets and the importance of respecting the intellectual property of the fact sheets.
- 2.2. Copyright. The fact sheet is copyrighted by the AASM and is subject to all applicable copyright, database protection, and other rights of the AASM as copyright owner under laws of the United States and other countries. The Licensee and Authorized Users acknowledge that they shall claim no ownership by reason of their use of or access to the fact sheets. Copyright notices in the fact sheets may not be removed, obscured or modified in any way. Unauthorized copying or redistribution of any material in the fact sheets are a violation of copyright laws.
- 2.3. Termination. This is a subscription service. During the subscription period, the Licensee may terminate this Agreement at any time by discontinuing use of the subscription. The AASM may terminate this Agreement if you fail to comply with the terms and conditions of this Agreement. No refunds will be provided for termination by either

party. Upon termination by either party, all rights to use the fact sheets will cease, and Licensee will promptly destroy all copies of the fact sheets in their possession or control.

3. Usage Rights.

- 3.1. Permitted Use. The fact sheets are furnished only for informational, educational, research and training use. All educational resources must properly recognize the author, the AASM. If you wish to make any changes to the educational resources, you cannot report that this is an original resource of the AASM. The Licensee and Authorized Users may:
 - 3.1.1. Access the fact sheets via a secure, electronic network which may only be accessed by Licensee Authorized Users. This Agreement grants the Licensee the right to store and maintain a copy of the fact sheets in a form accessible to Authorized Users at the Licensee's facility. This agreement grants the right to print and distribute fact sheets to Authorized Users.
 - 3.1.2. Utilize brief quotations from the fact sheets with customary acknowledgement of the source.
- 3.2. Prohibited Use. Use of the fact sheets other than as described in section 3.1 is cause for immediate termination of this Agreement without express written permission of the AASM. Prohibited Use of the fact sheets includes, but is not limited to:
 - 3.2.1. Use that does not conform to all applicable laws and regulations.
 - 3.2.2. Systematic or programmatic reselling, renting, redistributing, or other commercial use of the fact sheets in any form.
 - 3.2.3. Transmission or distribution of the fact sheets to individuals who are not Authorized Users.
 - 3.2.4. Alteration of the fact sheets
 - 3.2.5. Distribution or publication of the fact sheets on any electronic network other than an approved secured network that is available only to Authorized Users, including without limitation, the Internet and World Wide Web.

4. Disclaimer of Warranties.

- 4.1. The AASM warrants that it is entitled to grant the licenses granted in this Agreement and that the licensed material does not infringe the copyright or any other proprietary or intellectual property rights of any person, but makes no other warranties or representations of any kind, expressed or implied, including without limitation, warranties of merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose.
- 4.2. The AASM will not be liable for incidental, consequential, or any other damages arising out of or in connection with the fact sheets. In no event shall the total aggregate liability of the AASM for any claims, losses or damages arising out of a termination of this Agreement, whether in contract, tort or otherwise, including without limitation, due to negligence, exceed the total amount paid by the Licensee to the AASM for the subscription, even if the AASM has been advised of the possibility of such potential claim, loss or damage. The foregoing limitation of liability and exclusion of certain damages shall apply regardless of the success or effectiveness of other remedies. No claim may be made against the AASM unless suit is filed within six (6) months of the event giving rise to the claim.

4.3. In the event of a breach of this Agreement by the Licensee or Authorized Users, the Licensee agrees to indemnify and hold the AASM harmless from and against any and all claims, liabilities, damages, expenses, losses and threatened losses arising from, or in connection with that breach, including without limitation, claims of unauthorized use.

5. General.

- 5.1. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties and supersedes any prior communication between parties with respect to the subject matter hereof. Any purchase order or other instrument that the Licensee may issue for the fact sheets shall in no way amend the terms and conditions provided herein.
- 5.2. The AASM may make changes to this Agreement at any time without notice.
- 5.3. The Licensee shall not assign or transfer its rights under this Agreement.
- 5.4. Neither party's delay or failure to perform any provision of this Agreement, as a result of circumstances beyond its control (including without limitation, war, strikes, floods, governmental restrictions, power, telecommunication or Internet failures, or damage to or destruction of any network facilities) shall be deemed to be, or to give rise to, a breach of this Agreement.
- 5.5. The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this Agreement will not affect the continuation or enforceability of the remainder of this Agreement.
